STAFF TECHNICAL EXPERTISE

Our personnel undergo advanced training to maintain National Registry Certification as team members in the following roles:

- **EMT** (Emergency Medical Technician)
- **AEMT** (Advanced Emergency Medical Technician)
- **Paramedic**
- **PHRN** (Pre-Hospital Registered Nurse)

Our team manages conditions such as physical trauma, cardiac irregularities, respiratory distress, allergy/anaphylaxis reactions, seizures, and drug overdose reversals.

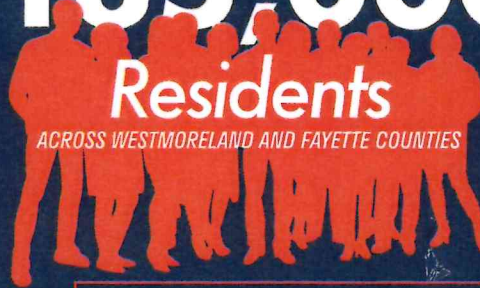

Services

NON-EMERGENCY AMBULANCE TRANSPORT

Transport services tailored to patients who require medical supervision during transit.

- > Ideal for patients unable to safely ride in a vehicle or wheelchair.
- > Services include transfers to and from healthcare facilities or private residences.

TACTICAL MEDICAL TEAM (TEMS)

Since 1992, our Tactical Medical Team (TEMS) has partnered with the Pennsylvania State Police to provide specialized EMS support.

- > Includes nine vetted, specially trained paramedics.
- > Team members are instructors in Tactical Combat Casualty Care (TCCC), with expertise in Care Under Fire (CUF), Tactical Field Care (TFC), and Tactical Evacuation Care (TACEVAC).

PARATRANSIT SERVICES

Wheelchair van services that cater to mobility-challenged individuals who don't qualify for ambulance transport.

- > Safe, CPR-certified drivers.
- > Hospital discharges and doctor's appointment transport.
- > Bariatric-capable wheelchair vans.



- > Deployments include Special Entry/Felony Warrant Teams, Dignitary Protection, Civil Disturbances, and Hostage Situations.

SPORTS & SPECIAL EVENT MEDICAL COVERAGE

Ensure safety at your next athletic event, parade, road race, festival, or conference with Mutual Aid's medical coverage services.

- > First aid stations, on-site medics/EMTs, and ambulance standby (ALS/BLS).

MOBILE INTEGRATED HEALTH (MIH)

This program aims to reduce unnecessary emergency department visits, hospital admissions, and readmissions.

- > Prevents infection exposure, reduces hospitalization-related stress.
- > Focused patient assessments and treatments performed in patients' homes, avoiding emergency department visits.
- > Patient-centered approach helps maintain support systems.
